

NHS CHARGES

In England, you will pay one of the Band charges depending on the dental treatment that you require. You will pay one Band charge for a course of treatment.

Band 1: £27.40

Band 2: £75.30

Band 3: £326.70

Urgent or emergency treatment: £27.40

Do I always have to pay NHS dental charges?

You are exempt from NHS Dental charges. If you are:

Are under 18.

Are under 19 and in full-time education.

Are pregnant or have a baby under 12 months old.

Receive Universal Credit, Income Support or income-based
Jobseeker's Allowance/Employment and
Support Allowance.

Are getting Pension Credit Guarantee Credit.

Have an HC2 certificate.

Have an NHS Tax Credit Exemption Certificate.
